1st DAY to 4th DAY

Arrival at Lisbon Airport. Meet & greet in English and private transfer to your hotel.

Stay in Lisbon for the next 4 nights and spend your time in this fantastic city. There is so much to see, from historic place s to the most recent museum and architecture projects, from the classic to the contemporary, from visual arts to performing arts, from listed monuments to new interactive exhibitions. In Lisbon there is always a unique show to see or an impressive monument to visit.

Included in the program:

Lisbon tour by **TUK TUK** with food & wine experience (duration 3 hours). 

The most authentic experience of Lisbon combining history, iconic sights and Portuguese gastronomy. See some of the typical Lisbon quarters from Bairro Alto to Chiado and Rossio, admire beautiful views of the 'city of seven hills' and experience some Portuguese 'tapas' & wines, and 'pastel de nata' & coffee.

Private Sintra & Cascais Tour 

A full day tour to discover the charming and picturesque town of **Sintra** (UNESCO World Heritage Site) that enchanted kings and inspired poets. Take your pick of any of the majestic Palaces, like the National Palace of Sintra, the Moorish Castle or the Pena National Palace, an astonishing fairytale castle located in one of the highest peaks of Sintra. Walk through the narrow streets and appreciate the handicraft shops.

In the afternoon travel to Cabo da Roca, the most westerly point of Europe, and admire the unique scenery of the Atlantic Ocean, the Guincho beach and 'Boca to Inferno'.

Continue to **Cascais**, a surprising and prosperous town and the most sophisticated and elegant area of the Lisbon coast. It is set along a beautiful bay of sandy and calm beaches, pinewoods and dream houses. Historically, Cascais was a minor fishing port, until the Portuguese nobility transformed the town into a summer retreat, filled with grand villas and lavish venues. It was once also the most popular place for the old European royalty to spend the bathing season. Travel through **Estoril** before returning to Lisbon and to your hotel.

(Not included: lunch and monuments entrance tickets)

Taylor's Wine tasting - Taste of three different wines and selection of cheeses.

Port Wine is one of the great classic European wines and its history is a long and fascinating one. Traditionally it is served towards the end of the meal with cheese, as a dessert wine or as an after dinner drink although some styles, like white Port, can also be enjoyed as an aperitif.


Fado Dinner

Night out for a Fado show and dinner with drinks at one of Fado restaurants in Alfama or Bairro Alto quarters.

Fado is the 'musical expression of the Portuguese people' with a UNESCO World Heritage status, as an urban Lisbon song symbolic of the city and the country. Literally Fado means 'faté' or 'destiny' and is considered Lisbon's version of the blues, marked by a heartfelt emotion voice and a Portuguese guitar. Each eruptive ballad evokes the Portuguese emotion of 'saudade', a longing for something lost.

5th Day - Check out from your hotel and private transfer to Lisbon Airport.
