AMBOSELI, NAIROBI, LAKE NAKURU & MASAI MARA - NATIONAL PARKS

SAFARI HIGHLIGHTS: This tour includes a visit to 3 of Kenya's Premium Parks. Including Amboseli, Nairobi Excursions, Lake Nakuru and Masai Mara. Amboseli NP is famous for its big game - elephants, lions and cheetahs are the main attractions - and for its great scenery beauty. Lake Nakuru NP home to the black & white rhinos. We will cruise through the Masai Mara, home to the 7th wonder of the world, the Wildebeest Migration. As we head to the Mara River in attempt to witness the spectacular Wildebeest River Crossing, we will also search for Kenya's magnificent big 5: The Lion, Rhino, Leopard, Elephant and Buffalo. A combination of luxury and adventure, this safari will let you experience the Magic of Kenya.

Day 1: Nairobi to Amboseli National Park

You will be met by our representative at the hotel for a short tour brief then transfer to Amboseli National Park, famous for its big game - elephants, lions and cheetahs are the main attractions - and for its great scenery beauty. Amboseli embodies five main wildlife habitats, plus a generally dry lake-bed - Lake Amboseli. These are open plains; extensive stands of yellow-barked acacia woodland; rocky, lava strewn thorn-bush country; swamps and marshes; and at the western end of the reserve, above Namanga, the massif of Ol Doinyo Orok rising to over 2,760m (8,300ft) and still for the most part zoologically unexplored. Enjoy your afternoon game drive at Amboseli National Park. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 2: Full day Amboseli National Park

Spend the whole day at the park or morning and afternoon game drives. The game drives take us in search of the diverse wildlife and birds drawn to the grasslands and seasonal flood plains of Amboseli, offering fantastic photographic opportunities. Depending on the guest, you could return early to the hotel to enjoy a refreshing swim and enjoy the views of the beautiful Mt. Kilimanjaro.

Day 3: Amboseli to Nairobi

After breakfast at the lodge/camp depart with a morning game drive en-route. Arrive Nairobi early afternoon for lunch the Famous Carnivore Restaurant. Visit the Giraffe Centre & the National Museum & Snake Park. Dinner & overnight at the hotel. The Sarova Stanley is a five star award winning Heritage Hotel rich in it's heritage & the 'birth' of Nairobi City centrally located right in the city center.

Accommodation: Sarova Stanley Hotel

Day 4: Nairobi to Lake Nakuru National Park

After your morning breakfast depart for Lake Nakuru. Enjoy your afternoon game drive in Lake Nakuru National Park. This Park which covers 180 sq km. The park is home to warthogs, waterbuck, buffaloes, reedbucks, and the occasional leopard. White and black rhinos were introduced to the park some years ago and you may find white rhino at the southern end. The park has also retained its reputation as an ornithologists' delight with more than 400 species of bird found here. Full board accommodation included in the tour price Dinner and overnight at the Lodge.

Day 5: Nakuru to Masai Mara National Game Reserve

Depart after your morning breakfast for Masai Mara Game Reserve. Wherever you go in the Mara you will see a frequent amount of wildlife such as Masai giraffe, baboons, warthogs, bat eared foxes, grey jackals, spotted hyena, topis, impala, wildebeest. Elephants, buffaloes, zebras and hippos also exist in great numbers. It is also common to see lions either basking after a heavy meal, or surveying the plains for their next meal. Cheetahs and leopards are harder to spot but are still reasonably common. The ultimate action here is without doubt the annual wildebeest exodus in July, August and September when millions of these grass eaters move north from the Serengeti in search of lush grass before turning south again in October. Full board accommodation is included in the tour price. Dinner and overnight at the Lodge/Camp.

Day 6: Full Day Masai Mara

After breakfast, head out for full day game drive toward the Mara River. Carry picnic lunch box to have lunch by Mara River. Return to the hotel for dinner & overnight.

Accommodation: Sarova Mara Game Camp

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Optional Activities:

1. Early morning balloon safaris. You will be dropped off at the takeoff site by the balloon company and picked up from your landing site by our safari driver. Balloon safaris are a romantic and evocative way of experiencing the wilderness of East Africa, as you gracefully and silently fly over the plains teeming with herds of wildlife in the early morning. Typically, a balloon safari begins at break of dawn, about 6 am, and lasts for around 1 hour, during which you will fly over parts of the vast Masai Mara plain, seeing the magnificent wildlife below, spread over several square kilometers of the reserve. Balloon flights are available daily in Masai Mara and take off from designated sites where the disturbance to animals is kept to a minimum. The flight is followed by a champagne breakfast "in the bush", with a well laid out seating arrangement and waiters on hand, to give you a fitting final to your memorable flight in the wild. Then you will start a game drive again with our driver guide. Picnic lunch offers wonderful scenery. The lunch box is packed by the hotel you stay. After lunch you will continue with game drive. **The cost is USD450 per adult.**

2. In the afternoon game drive, you can visit a village of the Masai people to witness the singing and dancing that are part of their daily lives and sacred rituals. A glimpse into their homes and social structure is a poignant experience. **The cost is USD 30 per adult.**

Day 7: Full Day Masai Mara

Head to the Mara River again with hopes of seeing the wildebeest crossing (Jul-Oct). If you have seen crossing yesterday, you can choose to return to the river or go around the Mara in search of the big 5 you have not spotted plus more of other resident wildlife. Again, you will have picnic lunches in the Reserve as you scale the Mara beauty. Return to the lodge before dusk for dinner & overnight.

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 8: Masai Mara to Nairobi

Enjoy your early morning game viewing at Masai Mara Game Reserve. Depart Mara for Nairobi with lunch enroute. Arrive late afternoon. Depending on your flight schedule, be transferred to the Airport or Hotel.

Accommodation: No accommodation

Meal: Breakfast & Lunch.
